

**English:**

In term 3, the children are learning a quest story, "The Enchantress of the Sands" by Jamila Gavin. They will be using this as a basis for writing their own story and as a stimulus for a recount text. In term 4, the fiction text will be "Why the seagull cries". Following this, pupils will be learning about the features that are needed in a discussion text, looking for examples when reading texts and practising writing their own.

**Maths:**

In maths the children will be developing their knowledge of different strategies for the four main operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, including practising written methods. They will also be learning to find fractions of amounts and to identify equivalent fractions. In addition, pupils will be practising measuring, including time, length, capacity and mass.

**Music:**

Pupils will be focusing on Call and Response. They will be performing and composing their own themed body percussion pieces as well as improving rhythmic skills in group sessions. They will continue to build on their keyboard skills as well as composing their own rainforest compositions. We will also be working on our Easter songs in preparation for the Easter service.

**Art/DT:**

In terms 3 and 4, the children will be studying the works of William Morris. They will learn about his life and use a variety of his pieces as a starting point for their own designs. Children will also investigate print making techniques and explore ways of combining and organising shapes, colours and patterns.



## Year 3 - Curriculum Map

### Terms 3 and 4 2018

**Science/Topic**

The children will be learning about light and animal habitats. In Term 3 we shall be learning about Light, discovering light sources and exploring which materials let light through. In Term 4 we will learn about animal habitats. In Geography, we will be studying Bloxham and the surrounding area.

**PSHE/JIGSAW:**

The topic in Term 3 is 'Dreams and Goals'. This theme provides time for children to reflect on themselves as individuals. Term 4 the theme will be 'Healthy Me' where children will consider what they eat and drink and what exercise they take.

**Collective Worship:** The focus of collective worship will be Courage in term 3. In term 4 the theme will be Forgiveness.

**RE:**

In terms 3 and 4 the children will be learning about miracles performed by Jesus and how this links to Belief. The children will also be learning about Lent and the Easter Story and its meaning for Christians.

**Computing:**

The children will learn to recognise some common types of programming error and practise solving problems through logical thinking. The children are becoming programmers using Scratch and presenting their work using Power point.

**PE:**

Mrs Ducker and Mrs Atkins will continue to teach outdoor PE and /or swimming. Swimming will begin on 06.02.18 for 3SH. During indoor PE the children will be developing their gymnastic skills, including balancing and using apparatus safely.

**French:**

The children will be revisiting their previous learning as well as learning names of food. In addition to this they will learn how to give and take instructions in French.
