

## English

The children will continue to use 'Talk4Writing' to write a comedy based on Shakespeare's Midsummer Night's Dream. They will invent their own tale and an information text to link in with topic-Formula One. They will be taught to use compound and complex sentences and different sentence types such as Commands and Exclamations. The children will focus on using a range of vocabulary including adverbs in a sentence. They will also be exploring a range of conjunctions and a variety of punctuation such as commas, exclamation marks, speech marks and the possessive apostrophe.

The children will be reading the text 'Flat Stanley' written by Jeff Brown in their weekly Reciprocal Reading sessions. SPAG sessions (spelling, punctuation and grammar) will review spelling and punctuation rules plus tips on how to spell irregular words.

The Readopoly Board will also begin. The children will move one place on the board for every book they read. It is essential that their reading records are signed as evidence.

## PE

In PE the children will learn a line dance as part of their Midsummer Night's Dream performance.

## Music

This term the year 2s will be exploring the world of film music. Pupils will have the opportunity to compose their own sound tracks for a Tom and Jerry cartoon using keyboards, percussion and everyday objects to create audio effects. Pupils will be looking at different types of films while analysing the mood and effect of the music to discover why music in film is so important. The children will also be learning songs for the Midsummers Night's Dream production.

## Science and DT

The children will be learning about plants in Science. They will also be making a car and testing it on different materials to see which car works the best and why. This will give the children an opportunity to plan, create, test and evaluate.

## Topic—Geography/History

The children will focus on locating the continents, oceans and countries on a map by linking it to where Formula One races occur. They will also develop their understanding of where Oxfordshire is and its surrounding counties by locating the team headquarters.

They will review different methods including Year 2 strategies. They will also continue finding the difference between two digit numbers. The children will develop their fraction understanding and its relationship to division. Time and money will also be recapped
